2020 E	3udget	Micky is concerned about a 32,000 deficit in the 2020 budget. The difference between 2019 and 2020 includes the loss of sponsor dollars and an increase in costs of the gift card program for legal fees and supplies. Many of our events do not have sponsorships and Alive at Five was very short on them this past season. Sean made a recommendation that we see a combined budget between DHI and BID to get a better picture of the organizations budget situation. This would need to be discussed in the MOU conversation with the BID board. We can consider a few options for the budget: increasing member dues, cuts to current spending, increasing sponsor dollars.
